



DEERFIELD TOWNSHIP CONVENIENCE CENTER RULES, REGULATIONS, USES AND LIMITATIONS

• **REGISTRATION**

- **Place to register** – Deerfield Township Municipal Building
- **Who may register** – Only the resident of the specific home located in Deerfield Township may qualify for free disposal of **approved** solid waste.
- **Who may NOT register** – Property owners including, but not limited to, Real Estate companies, Land Lords and Investors with property in Deerfield Township who do not physically reside at the specific location do not qualify for free disposal. Additionally, any resident who operates a business in Deerfield Township **MAY NOT** utilize the **FREE** disposal program.
- **What may be registered** – Each residence may register **ONE** vehicle with the township that will have approval to transport **approved** solid waste to the convenience center. Limitations of trailers may apply.
- **Where to place registration decal** – The registration decal issued to qualified resident must **PERMANENTLY AFFIX** the decal to one of driver's side windows. The decal must be clearly visible and unobscured by window tinting other visual obstacles.
- **Registration Limitations** – At no time and for no reason shall the decal issued by the Township to transferred to any other vehicle or person.

• **TRANSPORTATION OF APPROVED SOLID WASTE TO THE CONVENIENCE CENTER**

- The utilization of Tarpaulins (Tarps) is a **MANDATORY REQUIREMENT** for **ALL persons/vehicles** transporting waste to the convenience center.

• **APPROVED WASTE**

- **ONLY** Household Waste which is generated by the resident of the property located within Deerfield Township is approved. This resident may transport the waste in an appropriately township registered vehicle and only. Household waste shall include that which the resident generates during normal daily activities within the home and is normally deposited within the standard trash containers throughout the household.
- Only **MINOR** construction and or demolition debris **generated by the resident** shall qualify for the free disposal program. All construction and or demolition waste disposal **MUST** be accompanied by a current and valid construction building or demolition permit issued by the township.

• **OTHER INFO/RULES**

- The CCIA Solid Waste Complex is open Monday thru Friday from 7:30am to 3:30pm and Saturday from 8:00am to 12:00pm. **No waste will be accepted before opening or after closing.**
- Everyone **MUST** obey **ALL** signs including, but not limited to, Speed Limit signs (15mph), Stop signs and Yield signs.

Any person/vehicle that fails to comply with anything listed on this document will be DENIED access to the convenience center and may be exposed to summary actions in municipal court resulting in fines and possible revocation of convenience center privileges.
